

WEEK 1

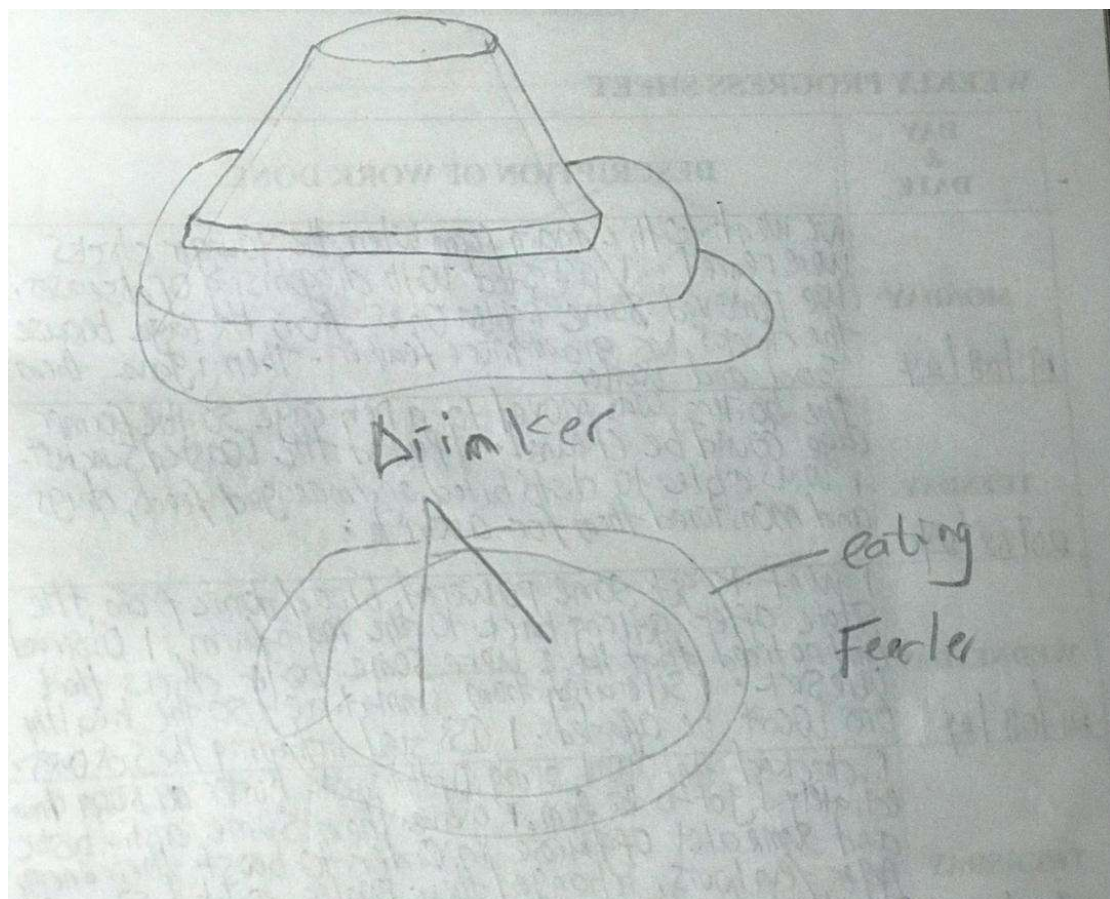
Tuesday: I assisted with vaccinating and administer medication to the birds because they seems so weak. Their feeding was changed because it was so dirty.

Wednesday: I went to get some powdered blood tonic from the store after getting back to the main farm, I observed and noticed that there were some broiler chicks that were sick. I separated them immediately so the healthy ones won't be affected. I assisted in treating the sick ones.

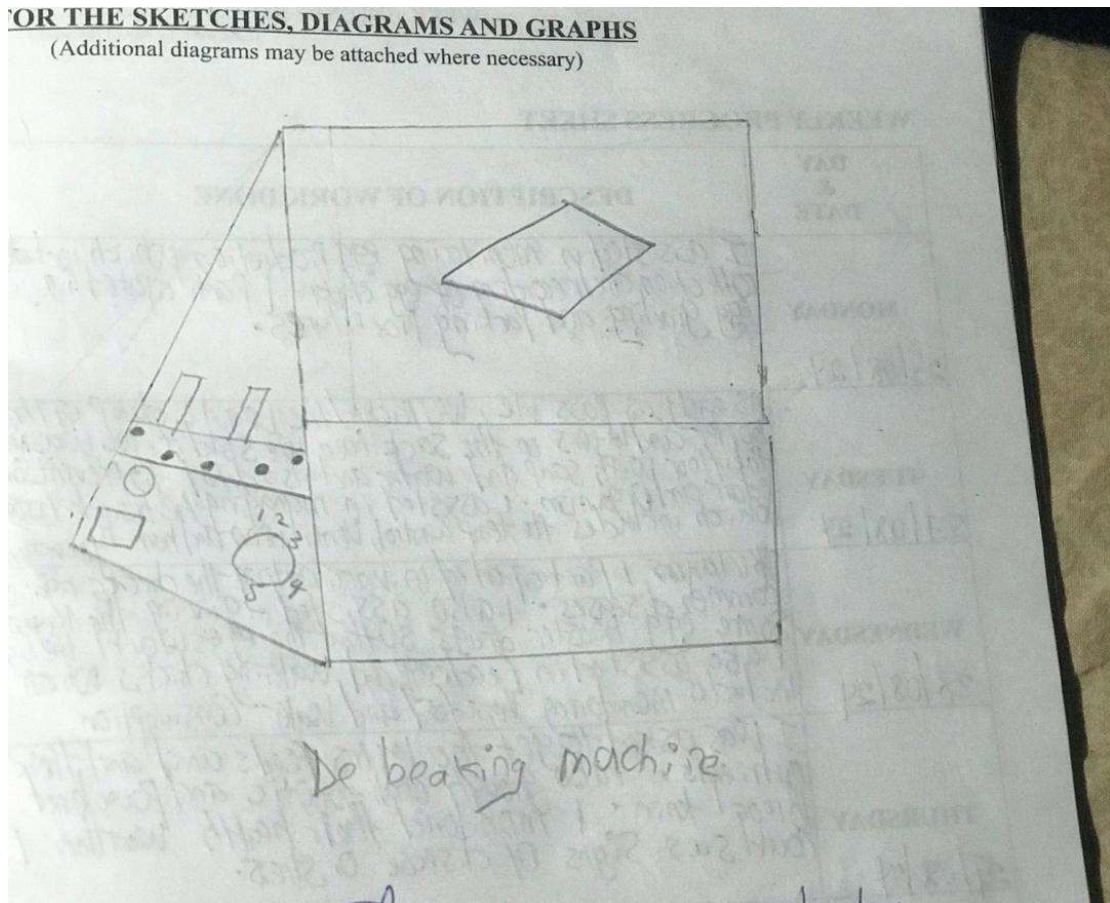

WEEK 4

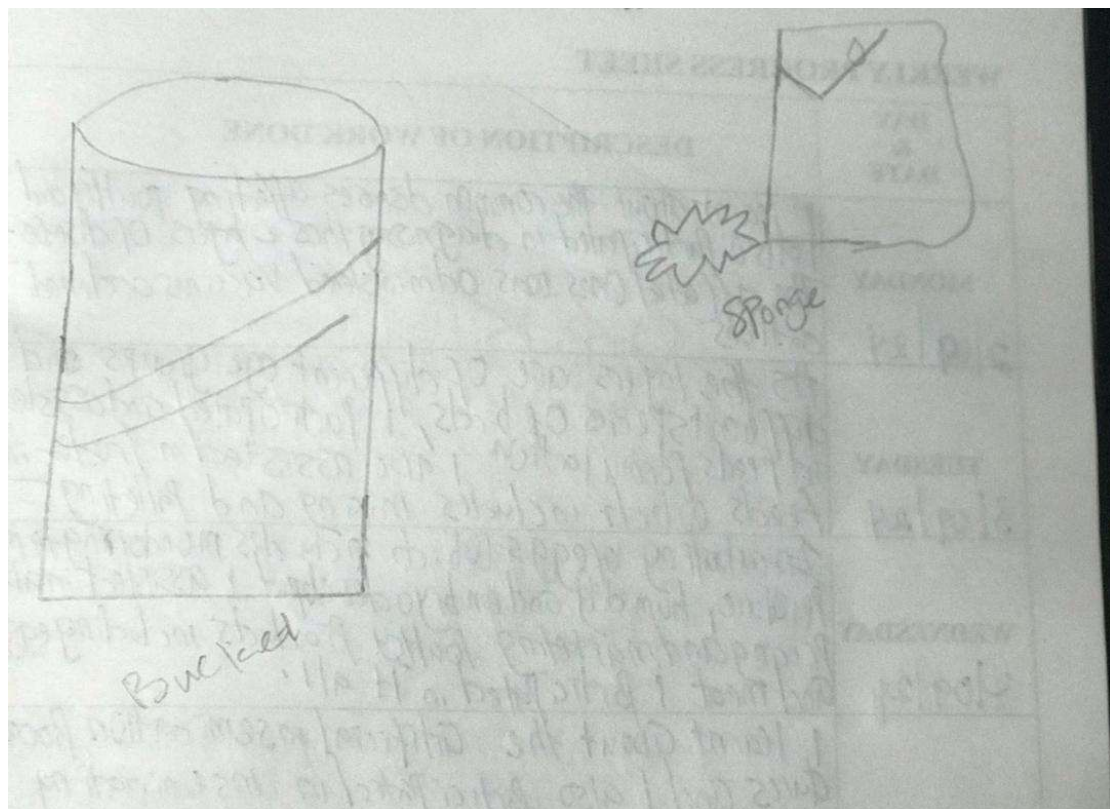
Monday: I assisted in monitoring egg production which includes collection and recording of egg data. I participated in egg grading and packing procedures

WEEK 5

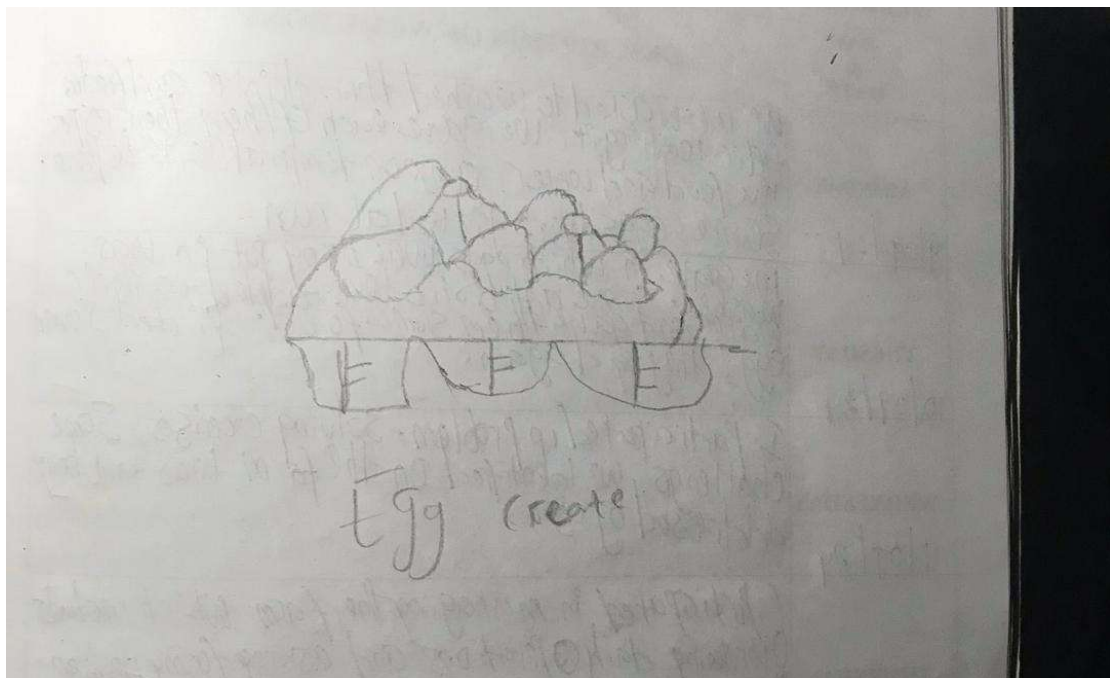
Monday: I assisted in monitoring egg production which includes collection and recording of egg data. I participated in egg grading and packing procedures

WEEK 6

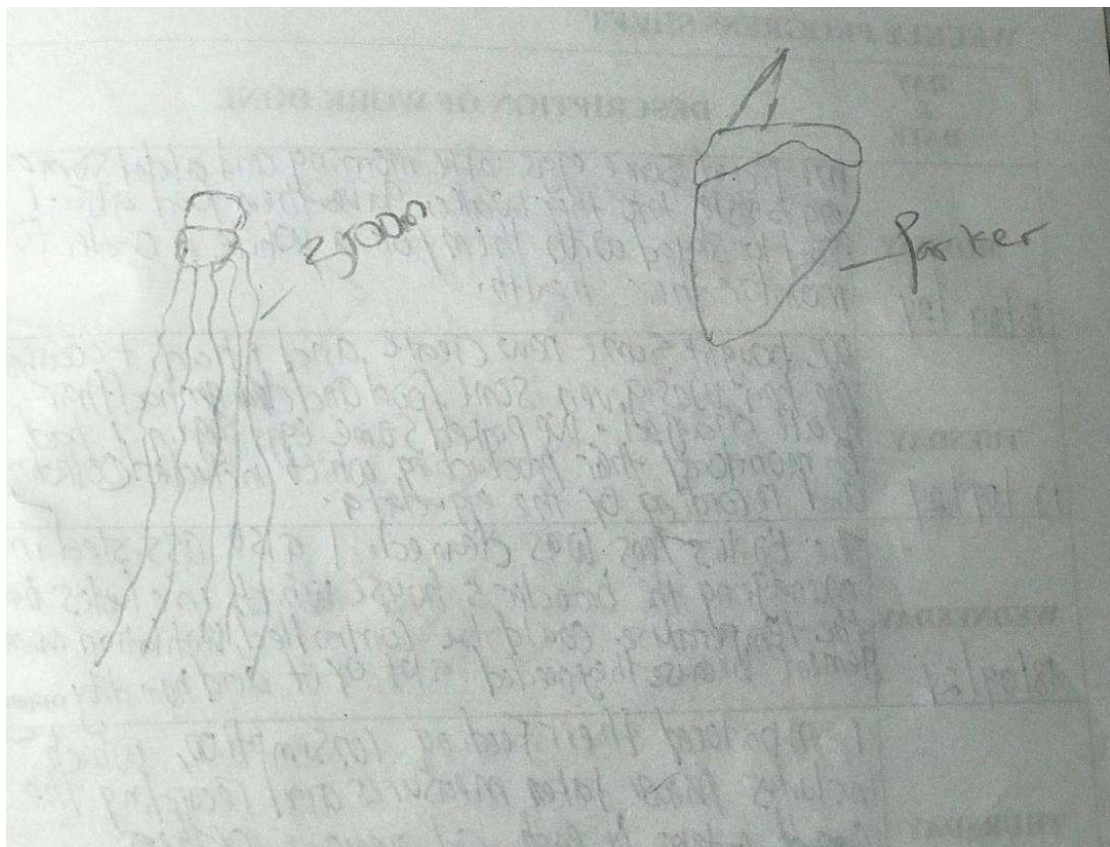

WEEK7

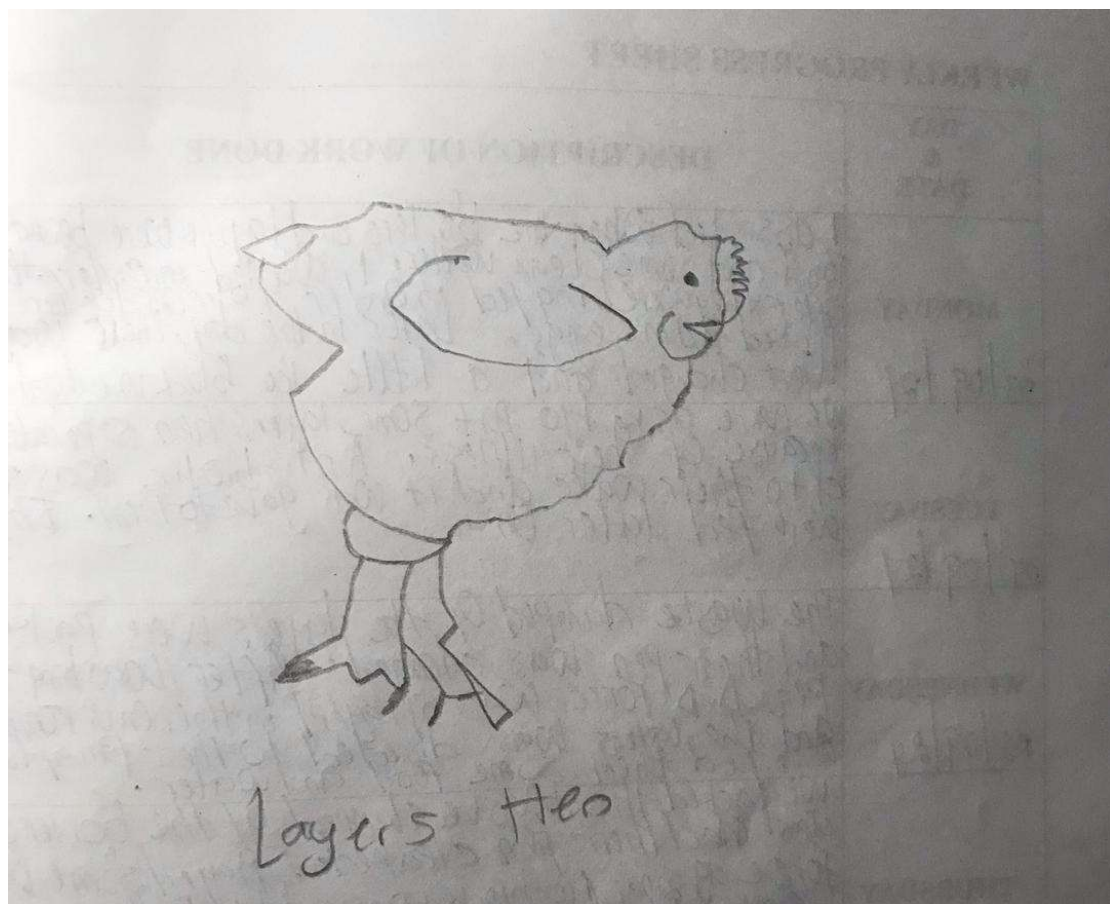
Monday: we picked some eggs in the morning and added some egg booster into their water, gave them feed also. I had to stay with them for a while so as to monitor their health.

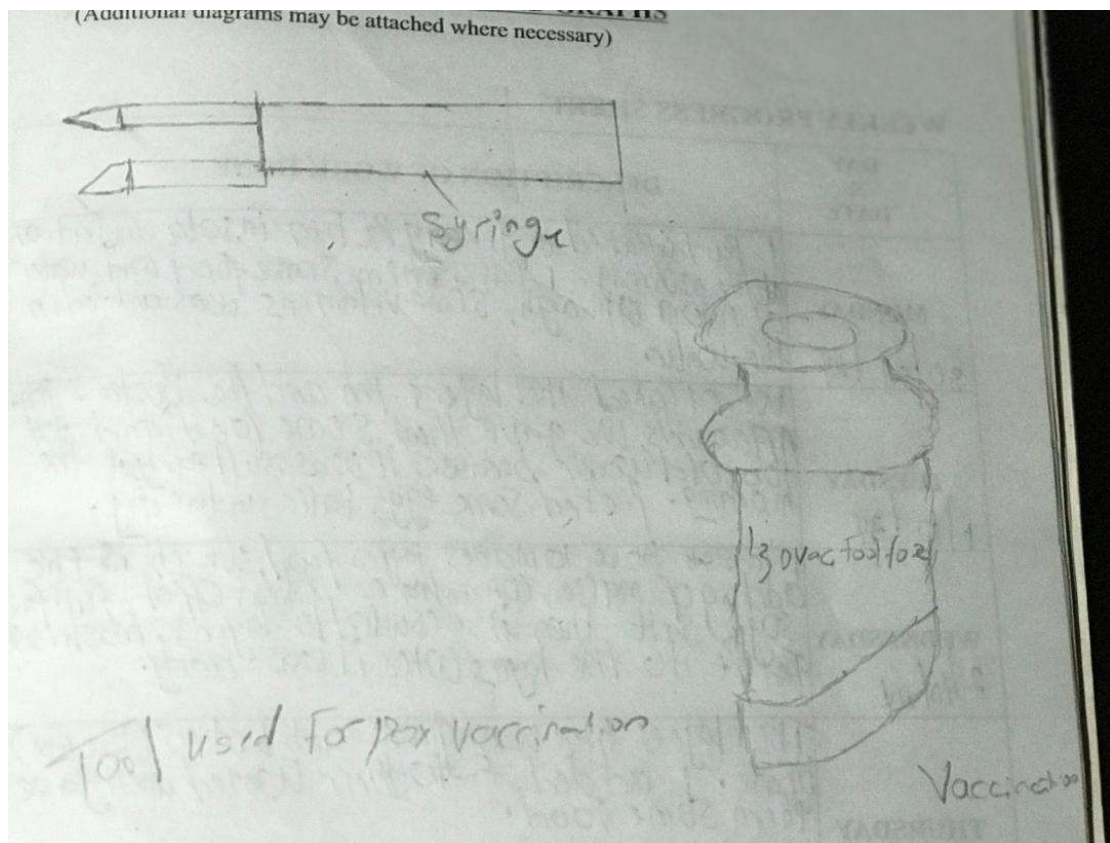
Tuesday: we were asked to put some layers hen separately because of their illness. Anti biotic was added to their water and it was gave to them. They were fed later on.

Monday: I participated in giving the hen lasota injection in the morning. I gave them some food and water at noon although some vitamins were added in the water.

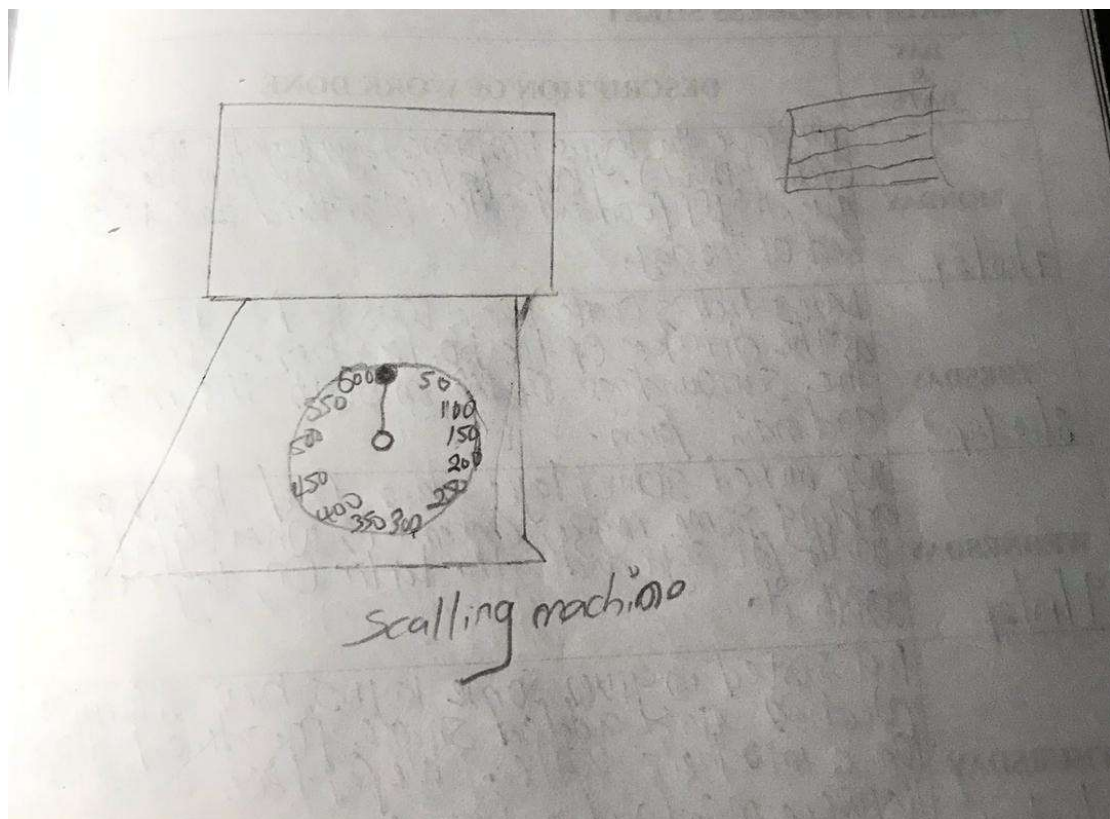

WEEK 10

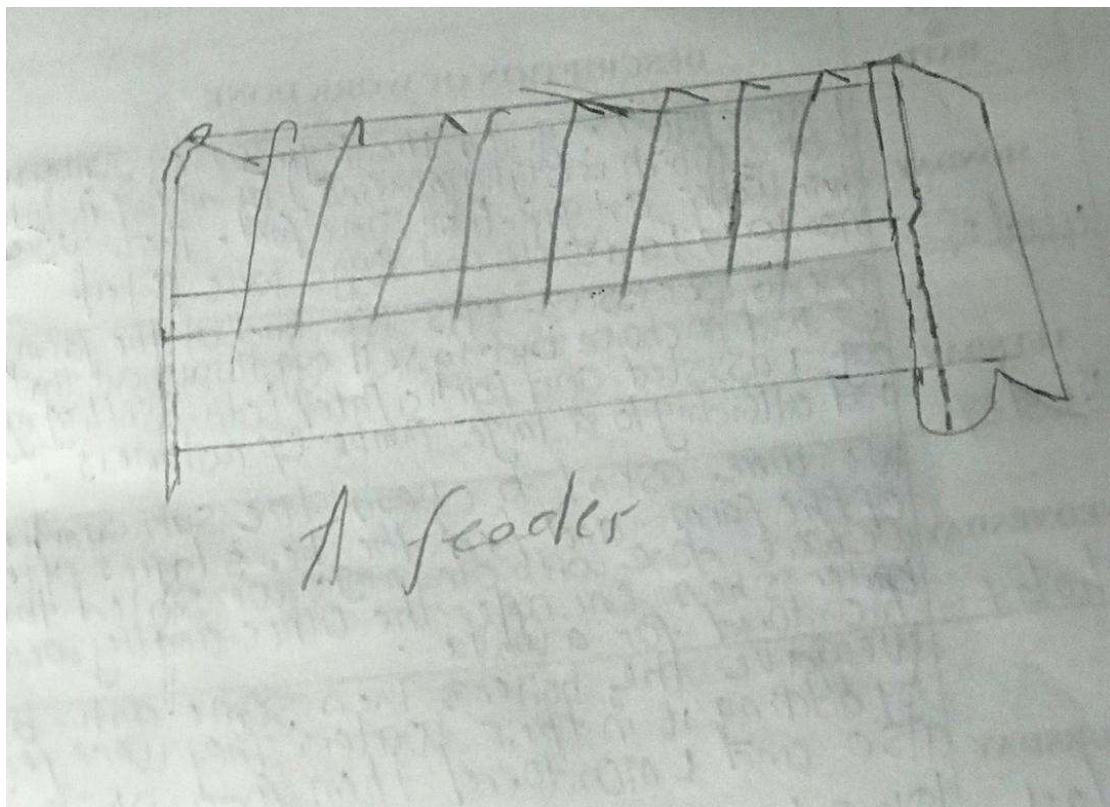
Monday: we gave the layers hen some santonella injection (fowl typhoid). Hours later , we gave them the same quantity of food and water, monitored them till the end of the day.

Friday: we cleaned the pipes that was passing water to the layers cage, and we packed the waste dump of the layer's hen, cleaned the pen after the spread of D.D force.



WEEK 11

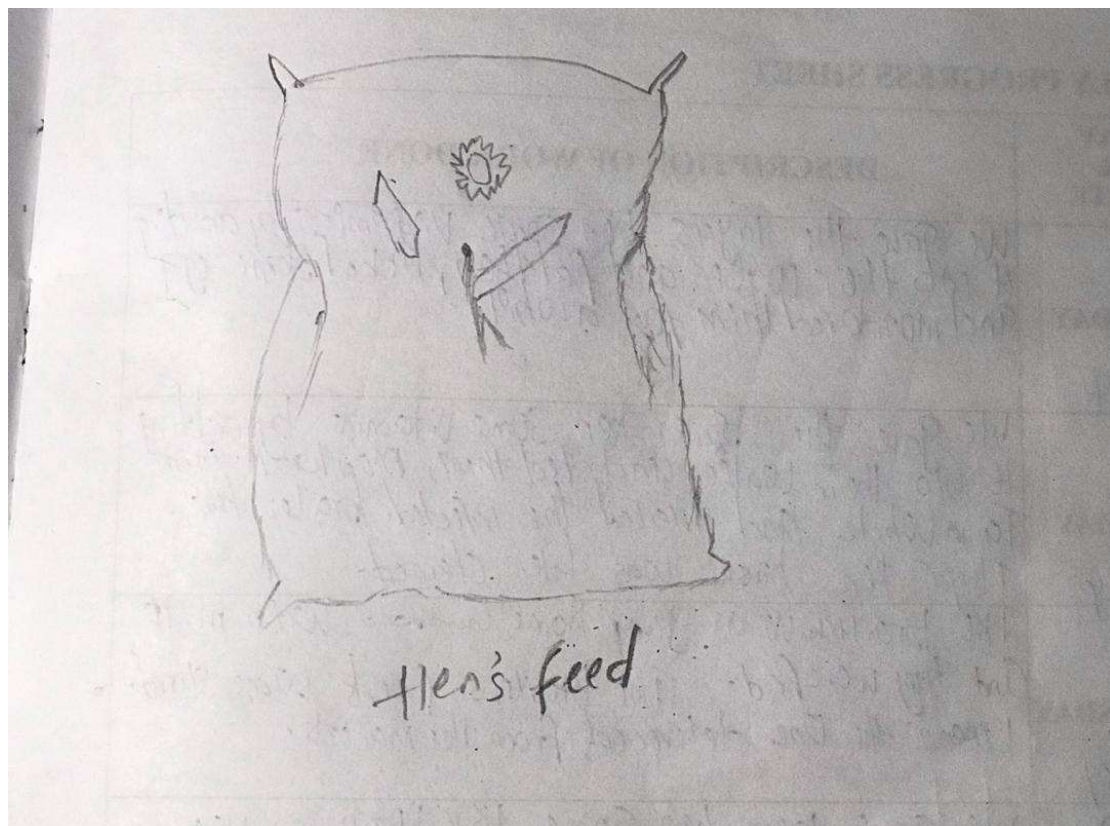
Monday: I participated in given the layer's hen some antibiotics by adding it into their water and gave them some food. There were monitored for a whole and eggs were picked

WEEK 12

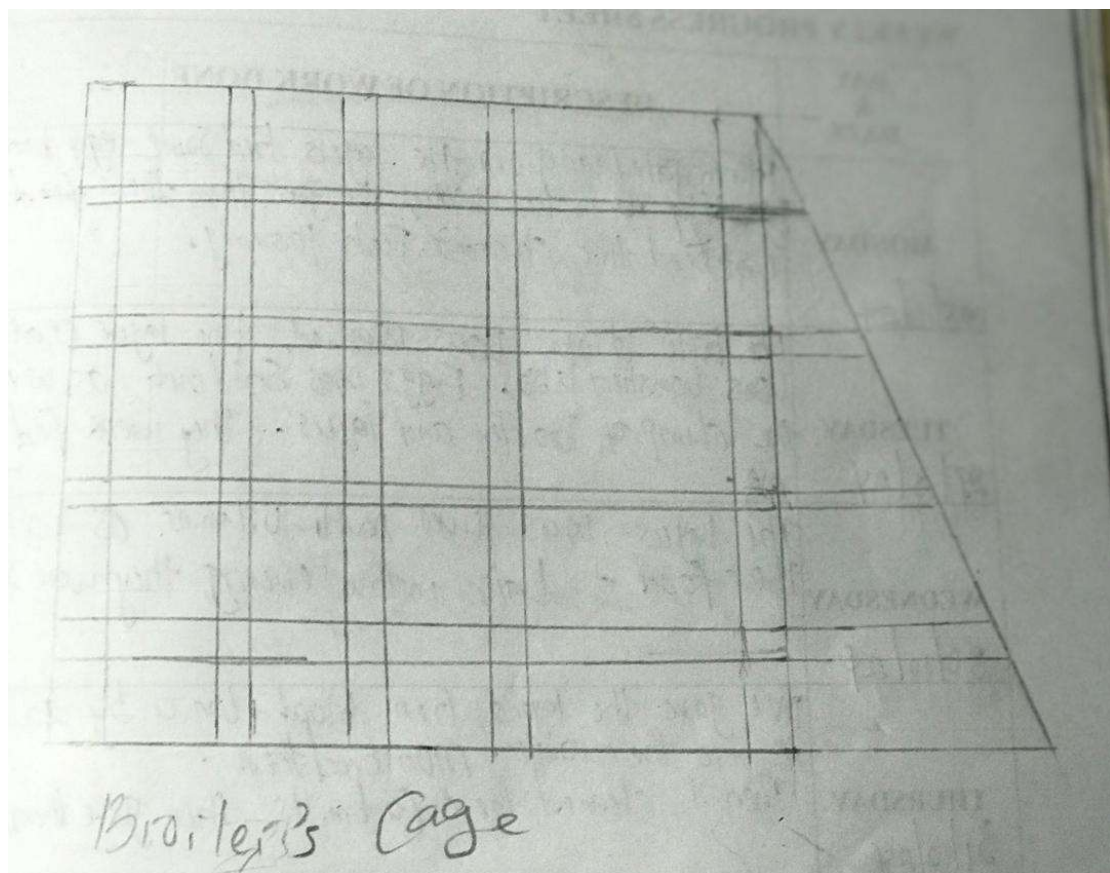
Monday: we gave the layers hen some vitamins by adding it into their water and fed them, picked some egg and monitored them for a while.

Monday: I participated in given the layers hen some egg booster by adding it in their water, we gave them their feed. I stored the chicken's feed personally.

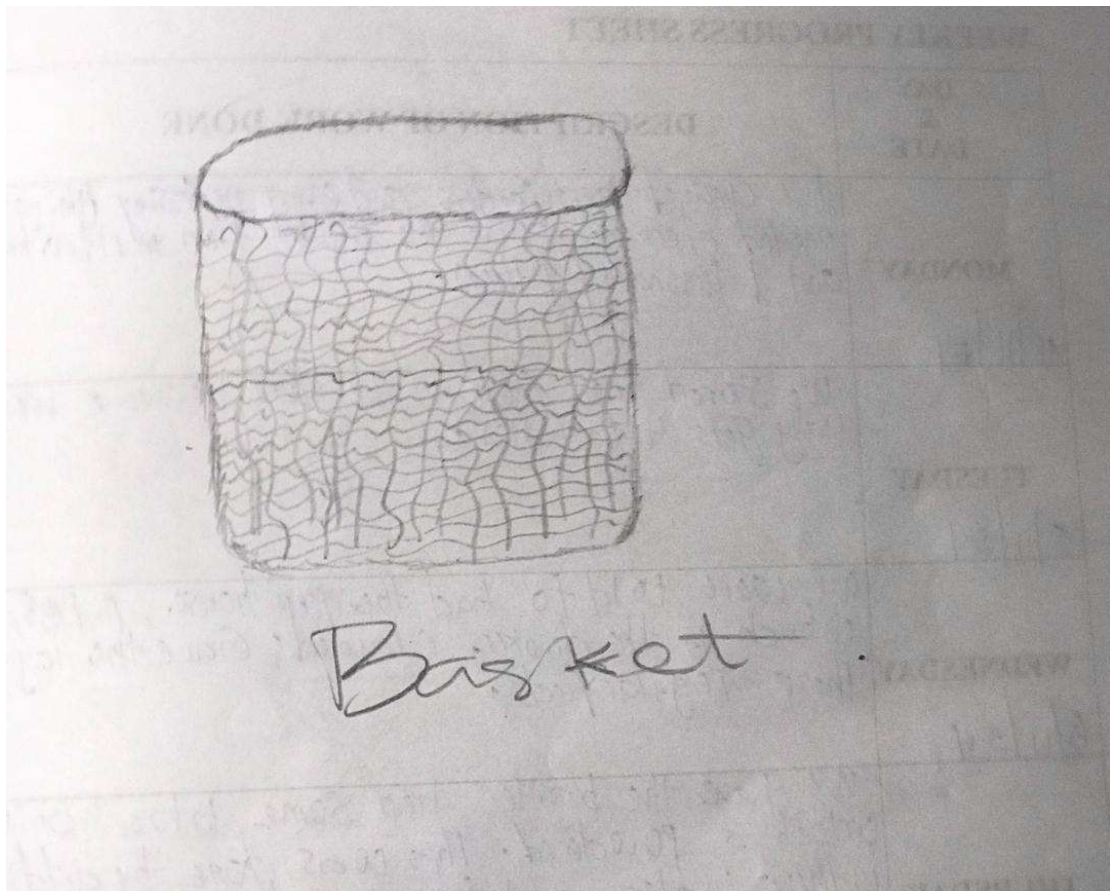
Tuesday: The broiler drinker was washed, the layers crate was washed also. Eggs was sold out as well as dump of broiler and layers. They were fed by me.

Monday: we cleaned their feeders and every necessary things that needed cleaning. Gave the broiler hen multi vitamin and I personally fed them.

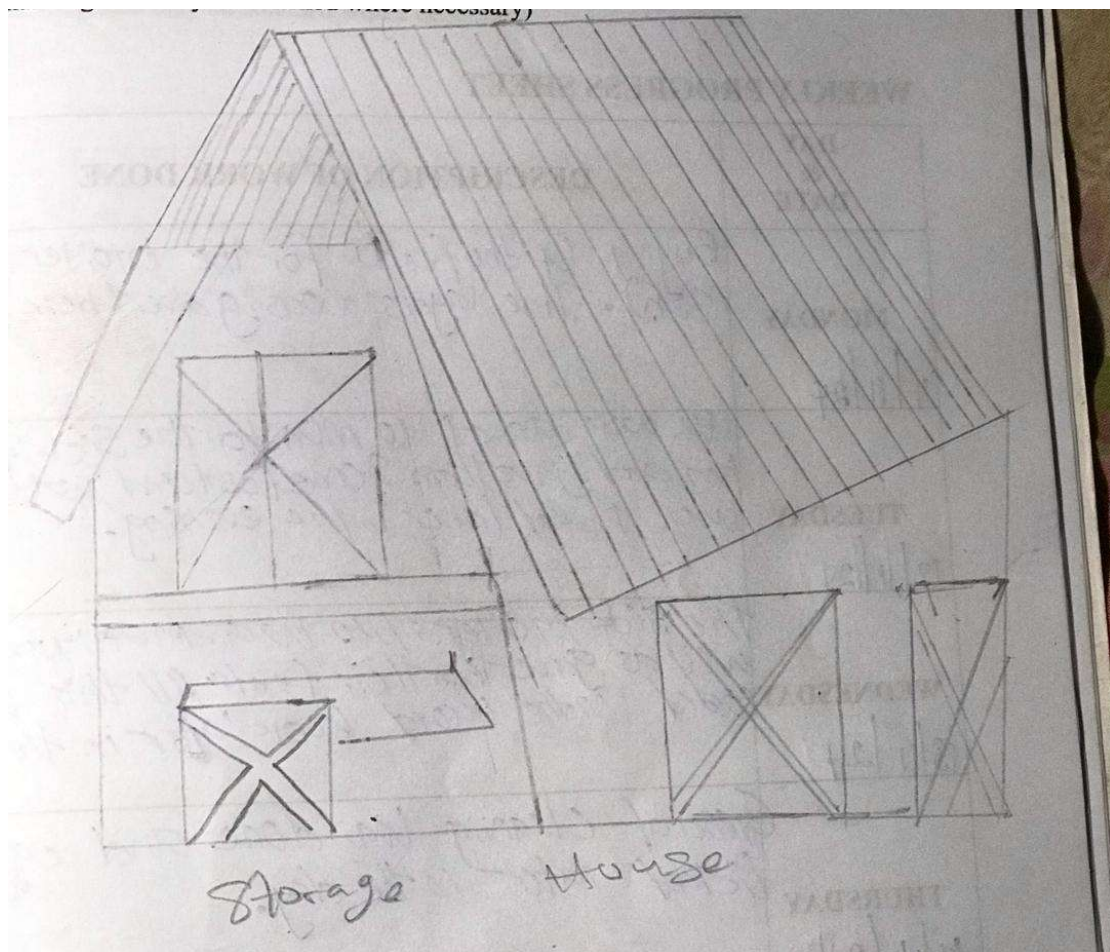
Tuesday: we stored their feed in the store because we usually gets it in bulks

WEEK 15

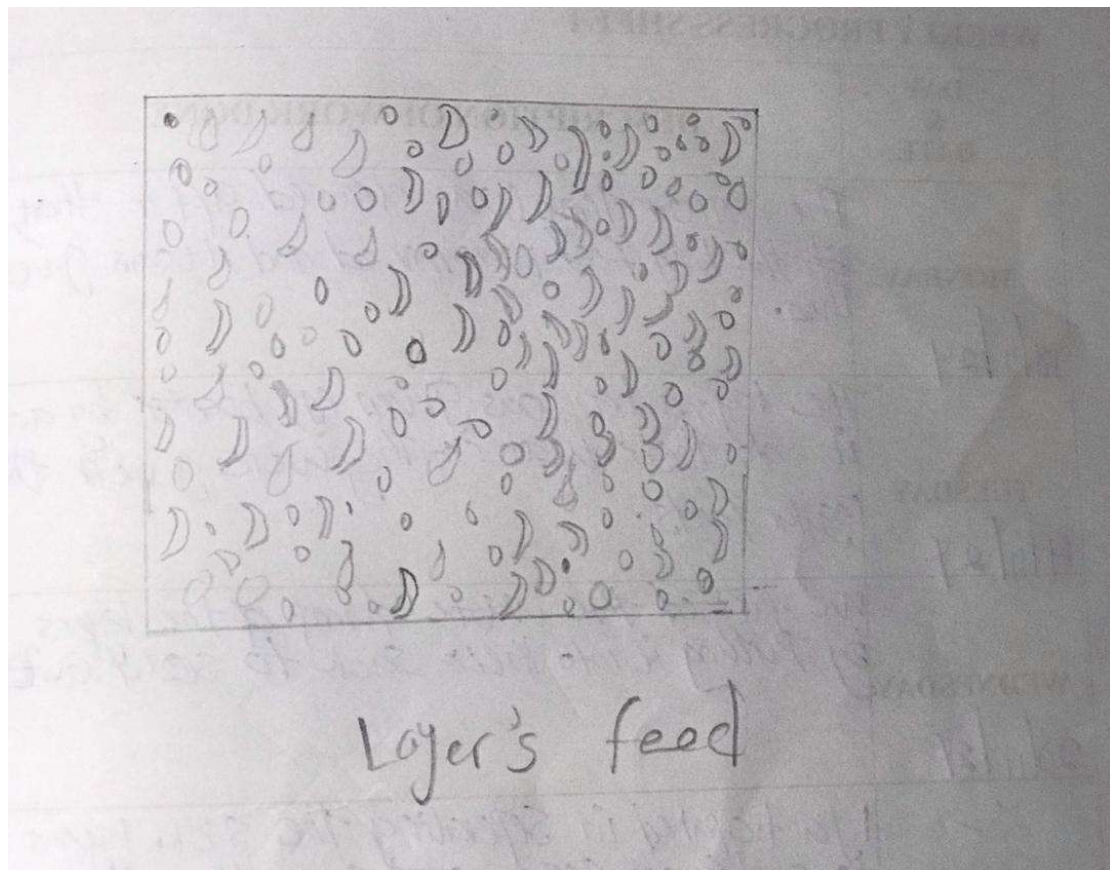
Monday: Buying of the feeds for the broiler(grower mash). The layers was gave their feeds.
