
OVERVIEW OF THE BROADCASTING STATION

Moreover, I was introduced to editor room, in which I learnt about the course of gathering and editing and alignment of news. I also taught on how to edit a voice record. After given a work to make a report on, then make a good voice over for a sport package report. I also monitor the editing of sport news by working with the production crew to produce news update on sport news and other available news related.

I was also taught how to present live programme in the studio. Although, it look strange to me because I have never being to a radio station making a live programme. If live programme was on, I have the privilege to enter the studio because I was chosen to be the spokesmen of the students during our staying at the station.

I was introduced to the studio where I learnt about the components of news. I also learnt how to do voice over without affecting the beat. I also participated in recording live programme. I also did a package report on entertainment news, where I learnt about product and programme advertisement both on radio and television.

I also learnt how to handle and control the mix console and much more about air light. I was taught how to make proper arrangement of ballow during live radio programme. I also learnt about the use of headphone while in the studio, and operating the mic console.

I had the opportunity to enter editing room to make a voice over of the news I gather and edited for broadcast. I did a package report on entertainment news.
