LOCATION: Taiwo Isale, Ilorin Kwara state

BACKGROUND OF CASE STUDY ONE

Christ Apostolic Church Oke Isegun, located in Taiwo Isale, Ilorin, Kwara State, has a rich

history dating back to 1946.

- Founding: The church started as a small congregation and has since grown into a prominent

district coordinating council (DCC) headquarters.

- Early Years: In the 1950s, the church introduced Sunday school as an educative arm, which

was taught by catechists. The Sunday school classes were held at 3:30 pm before the evening

service.

- Growth and Development: Over the years, the church has experienced significant growth,

with the construction of new facilities, including a 1,200-seater ultramodern English Assembly

Auditorium and a proposed 1,500-seater Joseph Ayo Babalola Events Hall.

- 75th Anniversary: In 2022, the church celebrated its 75th anniversary, marking seven decades of spreading the gospel and serving the community. During this celebration, the church dedicated its newly built auditorium and public address system, and laid the foundation for the events hall.

- Attack in 2018: Unfortunately, the church was attacked by miscreants on New Year's Day in 2018, resulting in damage to property and harm to worshippers. The Christian Association of Nigeria (CAN) condemned the attack and appealed to the state government to take measures to prevent future incidents.

Today, Christ Apostolic Church Oke Isegun continues to thrive, with a strong focus on evangelism, discipleship, and community service. The church has become a beacon of hope and spiritual guidance for its members and the broader community in Ilorin.


MERIT:

- There is church Secretariat where the affairs of all district headquarters and assemblies are carried out.


DEMERIT:


MERIT:

inaugurated in August 2022 by the church's authorities.

- The region comprises 70 DCCs and Zones, with Pastor Emmanuel S. Famuyide serving

as the pioneer Regional Superintendent.

MERIT


Enough sitting capacity to accommodate members.
